## When to Use NHS 111 or 999


It's important to choose the right service so you can get the help you need as quickly as possible.

### NHS 111 – Urgent but not an emergency

Contact NHS 111 if you:

- Need medical advice when the surgery is closed
- Are unsure where to get help
- Have an urgent health concern that cannot wait for a routine GP appointment
- NHS 111 can assess your symptoms, give advice, book you into an urgent care service, or direct you to the most appropriate service.



 Call 999 or go to A&E in an emergency

Call 999 immediately if someone:

- Has chest pain, signs of a heart attack or stroke
- Is struggling to breathe or has stopped breathing
- Has lost consciousness
- Is bleeding heavily and it won't stop
- Has a serious injury or sudden severe illness
- If it is life-threatening, do not wait — call 999 straight away.

- You still phone us as normal and EMMA will submit your query via Accurx for doctors to triage
- You can still use Accurx to submit your query
- You can always speak to a receptionist.
